Gesu School is an independent Catholic school, grades pre-K to 8, educating North Philadelphia's children in the Jesuit and IHM traditions. With your help, Gesu School empowers students to break through the barriers that confine them in order to realize a brighter future.

- Gesu has no selective academic admissions standards; admissions are on a first-come first-served basis, with priority given to our six surrounding zip codes.
- Ninety percent of Gesu alumni graduate from high school on time, while the city's on-time public high school graduation rate is only 61%. More than 68% of Gesu's high school graduates pursue post-secondary education, compared to 46% of the school district's African American graduates.
- Gesu School embraces the Jesuit ideal of *cura personalis* care of the whole person—and the IHM belief that every child can learn, building academic and social skills, character, and spirituality in students with a range of ability levels and from a variety of faith backgrounds.
- Gesu School's priority service area includes the three poorest zip codes in the City of Philadelphia; tuition revenue covers only a fraction of our costs. Critical financial support from donors and events, like our annual gala, provides our students with a quality, innovative education.
