wenty years ago, the Roman Catholic Church of The Gesu closed its doors, shaking the foundation of a struggling neighborhood just north of Girard Avenue and west of Broad Street. The fate of the parish's school, known as a beacon of hope to many neighborhood families—Catholic and non-Catholic alike—remained uncertain. At the Archdiocese's request, Gesu School voyaged into uncharted waters as a self-governed, self-financed independent school under the leadership of the Jesuits and the IHM sisters.

Thanks to the efforts and the contributions of many hardworking leaders, educators, volunteers and donors, Gesu School not only survived, it blazed the way for many schools that followed in its path, becoming a national model for inner-city education.

Gesu School empowers 450 children in Pre-K through 8th grade to reach their full potential. Most Gesu families struggle financially. More than a third live below the federal poverty level. Despite the challenges our children face, they succeed. While there are no selective admissions to attend Gesu, over 90% of Gesu's graduates complete high school on time, and over 75% pursue post-secondary education, all in a school district where the on-time high school graduate rate hovers around 60%.
